On The Day

Location

The Canungra Combat Challenge is held on base at the Kokoda Barracks off Beechmont Road, Witheren in the Gold Coast hinterland. The main entrance to the Barracks is Wau Road but the area will be signed on event day. Parking is available onsite - you are welcome to drive, carpool or bus (for larger groups) to the Barracks.

Timings

Teams will be assigned a wave start time between 0800 and 1015 and must arrive at least one hour prior. Wave times will be confirmed in the week leading up to the event. Depending on your team's fitness level, the course takes approximately one to three hours to complete.



On The Day

What to Wear

We encourage participants to wear long pants and long shirts to complete the course. (Long sleeve and long pants to limit abrasions caused by crawling on the grass and negotiating the Obstacle Course, this can be but is not limited to skins, lycra, etc.)

Jewelry, bracelets, watches and other electronic devices are not to be worn on the course, we encourage you to leave these at home (or in your bag at our baggage drop location). GoPro and mobile devices are also prohibited whilst completing the course. Bring a change of clothes - you will get wet!

Race Village

The fantastic Army Band will be on-site to bring teams to the race finish and we're sure you are going to work up a huge appetite, there will also be some awesome food and beverage vendors to make sure you feel full and refreshed after the Challenge.



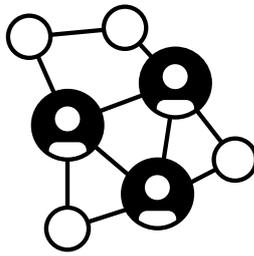
